for him Thereupon here Committed into the Custody of the Sheriff of
Kent County until he give Security as aforesaid

* Ordered by this Court here that the said Rich^d ^{enter into Reg^d Writ} give Security for
his App^r during Court Sitting and to abide the Judgment of the same
Court — Thereupon Rich^d Edwards & Abraham Falconer of Kent
County present herein Court in their proper persons Cometh here
and ~~Pray~~ Acknowledgeth the moneys Indebted to his Lordship the
right Honourable the Lord Prop^r of Maryle in the sum of twenty
five pounds Curr^t moneys of Maryle to be made & payed on his
goods and Chatter Lands and Tenements for the Use of his said
his heirs and Successors With Condition to the said Reg^d that Rich^d
Edwards make his personal App^r during Court Sitting and to
stand & abide the Judgment of the same. Then the Reg^d to
be void and to remain in full force in Law —
