pounds of tobacco each Goose of the good & Chattels of
a certain Nathaniel Cowley then and there being found
them and there felonously stole took & bore away
against the peace & against the form of the Act
of Assembly in such case made and provided. George
Allin at Kent County Court at the Court house in the Town
of Chester in said County on the the third Monday of March
being the twentieth day of said month in the year of Our Lord
Seventeen hundred thirty eight cometh the said Lord Proprietor
Joseph George his Attorney and prays that the said
Bowles Green to the action aforesaid may answer

And the said Bowles Green in his proper person cometh
defends the said and Injury when he and saith that he is in
no sort guilty of the promises aforesaid upon him imposed
as by the Judgment aforesaid it is alleged and thereof he putteth
himself upon the Country &c. Bowles Green in presence
of George

Thereupon Command was given to the Sheriff of
Kent County that he immediately cause to come here
