 Green being asked what he had to say why Judgment
 should not be given against him on the Verdict of the
 Jurors and upon which he praye Stay of Judgment
 which is granted and time is given until June Court
 next being the third Tuesday in said month At which
 said third Tuesday of June being the nineteenth day of said
 month in the year of Our Lord seventeen hundred
 thirty and eight Come again the sd Bowles Green in
 his proper person And the sd Lord Propy by
