Thereupon Bowler Green Joseph Mason and Benjamin Sutton of Kent County Planters and Provs herein Court in their proper persons Acknowledge themselves Indebted unto his Lordship the Right Honourable the Lord Propy of Maryland Bowler Green in the sum of fifty Pounds current money of the Province of Joseph Mason and Benjamin Sutton in the sum of twenty five Pounds like money each to be made and Sweyed on their body goods and Chattles Lands and Tenements for the
