At which said third Tuesday of June being the nineteenth day of said month in the year of Our said seven hundred thirty eight Simon Wilmer Gent sh^r of Kent County did return thereof to the Court here thenore Indorsed as fol^loweth

The Jurors for the Right Honourable the Lord Prop^r that now is for the County of Kent upon their Oath do present that Mary Norris late of Kent County was on the first day of May Anno Dom^o seven hundred thirty eight at Kent County's said Court committed fornication with a certain Man whose name the Jurors do not know and the said woman then & there did promise to have carnal knowledge of her body and then & there to begetton the body of her the said Mary Norris a Mollatto Bastard and to the Evil Example of all others in the like Case offending and against the peace and against the form of the Act of Assembly in such case made and provided by George
