County on the third Tuesday of June being the nineteenth day of said month in the year of Our Lord seventeen hundred thirty nine cometh the said ~~Edmund~~ Property by Joshua George his Attorney and prayeth that the said Edmund be to the judgment of this Court ~~And~~ the said Edmund in his proper person comes and defends the said and injury whereunto And saith that he cannot give any the Judgment of so as against him brought nor do he say but that ~~Edmund~~ he is guilty of the promise as above upon him imposed as by the Judgment of it is alleged and thereof Submits to the Court

Therefore it is considered by the Justices here to wit at that County Court at the Court house in the Town of Chester in said County on the third Tuesday of June being the nineteenth day of said month in the year of Our Lord seventeen hundred thirty nine that the said Edmund pay the sum of three pounds current money of Maryland as a fine for the assault of ~~Edmund~~ Also it is considered that the said Edmund pay the sum of four hundred twenty pounds of tobacco costs according on the promise as to the Officers of this Court &c

And now here at the said third Tuesday in June being the day of Year as last mentioned cometh the said Edmund in his proper person and prayeth that his & his Sureties recognizances taken for his appearance to this Court may be discharged

Ordered by this Court here that Edmund Dulany Alexander Adair and Philip Christfoild their Recognizances taken as aforesaid be discharged as prayed

Edmund Dulany Alex Adair & Philip Christfoild their Recognizances taken as aforesaid is by this Court their discharge had being no cause shown to the contrary &c

All which said day & year as cometh Phillip Christfoild Joseph Woodall in their proper persons and prayeth that their Recognizances taken as aforesaid for their appearance to this Court as Evidence in behalf of his Lordship against the said Edmund may be discharged
