Cepi Corpus of S Wilmer Sheriff of Kent County The Jurors for the right honourable the Lord Dazoy that now is for the body of Kent County upon their Oath do present that Margarott Dazoy late of Kent County Spinster on the first day of May Anno Domini seven hundred and thirty eight at Kent County of fornication with a certain Man to the Jurors unknown did commit and the same person there and there did permit to have carnal knowledge of her body and then and there to begett on the body of her the said Margarott Dazoy at Chelster and to the Evil Example of all others in like case offending against the peace of and against the form of the Act of Assembly in such case made and provided do
