Kent County &c The Jurors for the right honorable the Lord Propy of that now is for the County of Kent upon their Oath do present that John Cannady late of said County Plaintiff on the seventh day of June Anno Domini Seventeen hundred thirty Nined with force and Arms at the County aforesaid upon a certain Samuel Barker in the fear of God and the said Lord Propy then and there being an Assault did make and him the said Samuel Barker did then & there beat wound and willy beat and other harms to him then and there did to the great damage of him the said Samuel Barker and against the peace &c
