of to Testify in behalf of his Lordship against the said  
Edmund Dulany Then this Requirance to be void Else to  
remain in full force in Law — B. Hands

Ordered by this Court here that the said Edmund Dulany  
enter into Requirance <sup>with Security</sup> for his appearance & good behaviour  
to next August Court Especially to Priscilla his wife  
Thereupon Edmund Dulany Hugh Matthews  
William Murray of Kent County Physicians present  
before Court in their proper persons acknowledged  
themselves to be indebted unto his Lordship the Lord Proprietor  
of the Province of Maryland Edmund Dulany in the  
sum of forty pounds current money of the Province of  
Hugh Matthews & William Murray in the sum of  
twenty pounds like money each to be made and charged  
on their body goods and chattels Lands and Tenements  
for the use of his said Lordship his heirs & Successors  
With Condition to this Requirance that Edmund
