The Writ of the said Judgment was Judged by the said George Ignoramus Jas Riggold forman Ordered by this Court here that the said John give Security for the Fees accruing on the premises as to the officers of this Court. And he having no One to Offer nor no one offering for him Thereupon he is committed into the custody of the Sheriff of Kent County until he give Security as aforesaid

And was here to wit at Kent County Court at the Court house in the Town of Chester in said County on the third Tuesday of June being the nineteenth day of said month in the year of Our Lord Seventeen hundred thirty nine cometh the said Matthew Kemner in his proper person & prays that his said Surety be taken as aforesaid may be discharged

Ordered by this Court here that Matthew Kemner James Moor & Salathiel Donmond their recognizances taken as aforesaid be discharged as prayed

Matthew Kemner James Moor and Salathiel Donmond their recognizances taken as aforesaid is by this Court here discharged their being no cause shown to the contrary
