Therefore it is considered by the Justice here to wit at  
Kent County sh<sup>rs</sup> at the Court house in the Town of Chester in  
said County on the third Tuesday of August being the fiftenth  
day of said month in the year of Our Lord seventeen hundred  
thirty & eight that the sd<sup>rs</sup> Edward pay the sum of two  
pounds ten shillings current money of Maryland as a fine  
for committing the offence aforesaid Also it is considered by  
the Justice aforesaid at the time and place aforesaid that the said Edw.  
pay the sum of five hundred and eight pounds of tobacco  
cost accruing on the premises aforesaid to the several Officers  
of this Court
