Ordered by this Court that John McCracken his
recognizance taken as aforesaid be discharged as prayed

by this Court here discharged there being no cause shown
to the contrary

His Lordships } Command was given to the
Sheriff of Kent County on the 19th day
of June in the 25th year of Our
Lord 1739 that he should
take Samuel Sawreus late of Kent County Sheriff if
he should be found in his Bailwick and him safe keep
so that he have his body immediately before this Court
now held at the Court house in Chester Town in Kent County
to answer unto such things as should be Objected
against him on his Lordships behalf on suspicion of
perjury And that the said Sheriff have at the time
of his appearance at the said precept And now here at
the said nineteenth day of June at Kent County Court
