Samuel enter into recognizance with Security for his app<sup>r</sup>  
and good behaviour to the use of Court of Assize to be held for  
in this County of Kent

Thereupon Samuel Lawrence and John Gale of  
Kent County Planters and present herein Court in their  
proper persons Acknowledgeth themselves to be Indebted  
unto his Lordship the Lord Proprietor of Maryland in the sum  
of fifty pounds current money Each to be made & conveyed  
on their body goods & chattels Lands & Tenements for  
the use of his said Lordship his heirs & Assigns with  
Condition to this Recognizance that Samuel Lawrence as  
maketh his personal Appearance before the Judge of  
our next Court of Assize to be held for the County of  
Kent & there to Answer unto such things as should be  
Objected against him on his Lordships behalf on charge  
of Perjury And in the mean time to keep the peace  
& be of good behaviour Then this Recognizance to be  
Void & to remain in full force in Law

Ordered by this Court here that James Greenwood  
as ~~doth~~ enter into recognizance for his Appearance  
(as an Evidence in behalf of his Lordship against the  
as Samuel) at the next Court of Assize to be held  
for the County of Kent

Thereupon  
James Greenwood of Kent County Planter present  
herein Court Acknowledgeth himself Indebted to his  
Lordship the Lord Proprietor of Maryland in the  
sum of ten pounds current money to be made  
and
