 that he the said Edward Williams do pay the Four hundred  
 and fifty pounds on the premises and to the several Officers of  
 this Court Then this Recognizance to be void and  
 to Remain in full force in Law

And now here to wit at Kent County and at the Court House  
 in the Town of Chester in said County on the third Tuesday  
 of August being the fifteenth day of said month in the year  
 of Our Lord Seventeen hundred thirty Eight Cometh  
 Edward Williams in his proper person and prayeth  
 that his and his Sundrys Recognizance taken as aforesaid may  
 be discharged

Ordered by this Court here that Edward Williams & Morris  
 Cloak their Recognizances taken as aforesaid be discharged  
 as prayed

Edward Williams & Morris Cloak their recogni-  
 zation as aforesaid is by this Court here discharged there being no  
 cause shown to the contrary

At Which said day and year aforesaid mentioned cometh  
 William Simcocke hereunto Court and prayeth that his  
 Recognizance taken as aforesaid may be discharged

Ordered by this Court here that William Simcocke  
 his Recognizance taken as aforesaid be discharged as prayed

 no cause shown to the contrary
