Ordered by this Court here that Edward Worrell (Master to the ap Margaret) deliver her up to the Court at the Exigⁿate of her bond of Surety, there to make Satisfaction to the same Court for the fees accruing on the premises ap according to Act of Assen^y by the — *Sam^l Smith*
