Ordered by this Court here that Benjamin Green enter into Recognizance for his Appearance (to next November Court) as and Evidence in behalf of his Lordship against the ap William Graves

Thereupon Benjamin Green of Kent County Planter and present here in Court in his proper Person Acknowledgeth himself Indebted to his Lordship the Lord Proprietor of the Province of Maryland in the sum of ten pounds current money of the Province to be made & payed on their body goods and chattels Bonds & Tenements for the Use of his said Lordship his heirs and Successors With Condition to this Recognizance that Benjamin Green do make his Personal Appearance before the Justices of our next November Court then and there to give Evidence in behalf of his Lordship against the ap William Graves Then this Recognizance to be void to remain in full force for Year

now here to wit at Kent County Court at the Court house in the Town of Chester in said County on the third Tuesday of August being the twenty first day of said month in the year of Our Lord fourteen hundred thirty and nine cometh the ap David in his proper Person and prayeth that he and his Surety Recognizance taken as above mentioned may be discharged

Ordered by this Court here that David Crane and Thomas Williams his Surety their Recognizance taken as ap be Discharged as prayed

David Crane & Thomas Williams their Recognizance taken as ap is by this Court here Discharged there being no Cause shown to the contrary

At which said day and year ap last mentioned cometh here into the ap County Court Hugh Morrison and prayeth that his Recognizance taken as ap may be Discharged

Ordered by this Court here that Hugh Morrison his Recognizance taken as ap be Discharged as prayed
