At Which said day and year ap at Kent County Court ap cometh again the ap George Clark in his proper person and prayeth that his recognizance taken as ap for the appearance of Mary Wood as servant to this Court may be Discharged

Ordered by this Court here that George Clark his recognizance taken as ap be Discharged as prayed George Clark his recognizance taken as ap is by this Court here discharged there being no cause shown to the contrary

Ordered by this Court here that the ap David Brand enter into recognizance with security for his appearance and good behaviour (to next November Court) especially towards a certain Mary Wood

William of Kent County present before Court in their proper person acknowledged themselves indebted to his Lordship the Lord Prop^r of the Province of Maryland in the sum of twenty pounds current money Brit to be made & recovered on his body goods and chattels lands and Tenements for the use of his said Lordship his heirs and Successors With condition to this recognizance that David Brand ap make his personal appearance before the Justices of Our most County Court to be hold at Our Court House in Chester Town in the County ap on the third Tuesday of Novem^r next then and there to answer unto such things as shall be objected against him on his Lordships behalf And in the mean time to keep the peace & be of good behaviour (especially towards the ap Mary Wood) that this recognizance be void And to remain in full force in Law

Ordered by this Court here that Hugh Morrison enter into recognizance for his appearance at next Nov^r Court
