by the Justice here to wit at Kent County Court at the Court
Held in the Town of Chatham in said County on the third Tuesday
of August being the twenty first day of said month in the year
of Our Lord present one hundred thirty & nine that the sd. Jane
pay the sum of Pounds of Tobacco
cells accruing on the promise as to the several Officers
of this Court &c.

Ordered by this Court that the sd. Jane give Security for
her Appearance during Court sitting.

Whereupon Thomas Crow of Kent County Planter Present
herein Court in his proper Person Acknowledgeth himself to
be Indebted to his Lordship the Vard property of Mary said in
the Sum of ten pounds current money to be made and received
in his body goods and chattels Lands and Tenements for the
Use of his said Lordship his heirs Successors With Condition
to this Recognizance that Jane sd. make her Personall
Appearance before the Justices of this present Court during
the sitting of the same, To Answer unto such things as
should be objected against her on her Lordships behalf
Then this Recognizance to be void &c to remain in full
force in Law

At Which said third Tuesday of August being the day and year
as last mentioned cometh the sd. Jane in her proper Person
& prays that her ^{Recognizance} taken as aforesaid may be discharged
Ordered by this Court that Thomas Crow his Recognizance
taken as aforesaid be Discharged as prayed

Thomas Crow his Recognizance taken as aforesaid by this
Court be Discharged there being no cause shown to the
Contrary
