And the said John in his proper person and the Jurors of that Jury being impeached and called likewise came to wit. Griffith Jones, Thomas Bordley, Chris. Billian, John Comdays, John Webb, Hans Hanson, William Graves, John Redgrave, Peter Jones, David Jones, Joseph Hull, Sullener Middleton, who being duly Elected tryed and Sworn to say the truth in the Office And the said John Edmew appearing to the Verdict of the Jurors and upon their Oath do say that the said John is guilty as he is indicted and by Griffith Jones, their foreman all so say & Therefore it is Considered by the Justices here to wit at Great County as at the Court holden in the Town of Chester in said County on the third Monday of June being the twentieth day of said month in the year of our said Justices hundred thirty & Eight that the said John stand half an hour on the Pillary in the County as aforesaid and shall be whipt at the public Whipping post of the same County with five lashes upon the bare back of him the said John and the blood to appear Also it is Considered at the said time and place as that the said John pay the sum of Eight hundred & thirty One pounds of Tobacco Costs accruing on the promise as to the Officers of this Court &c

Ordered by this Court here that the said John give Security for the Fees accruing on the promise as to the severall Officers of this Court

Thereupon John Edmew and Benjamin Calmer in their proper person come and before the said Justices do together themselves Indebted unto his Lordship the Vice Propy of Maryland in the sum of fifteen hundred pounds of Tobacco each to be made Levyed on their body goods and Chattell Lands and Tenements for the use of his said Lord ship his heirs & Successors With Condition that the said John Edmew do pay the Fees accruing on the promise as to the Officers of this Court There this Recognizance hold void to remain in full force the said Justice in Law James Boyer being an Evidence for behalf of the
