in the sum of five Hundred pounds of tobacco each to be made and Seized on their body goods and Chattels Lands and Tenements for the use of the said Lord ship his heirs and Successors With Condition to the Recognizance that he the said William Pope shall pay the fees Accruing on the premises as to the Soverall Officer of this Court Then this Recognizance to Void And to remain in full force in Law

At the now held to wit at Great County as at the Court house in the Town of Chester in said County on the third Tuesday of August being the fifteenth day of said month in the Year of Our Lord Seventeen hundred thirty and eight cometh William Pope and prayeth that his said this Surety Recognizance taken as aforesaid for his Appearance to this Court may be discharged

Ordered by this Court here that William and Hugh Morrison his Surety, their Recognizance taken as aforesaid be Discharged as prayed

William Pope and Hugh Morrison their Recognizance taken as aforesaid is by this Court here discharged there being no cause shown to the contrary

At which said day and year as last above mentioned cometh William Burcann herinto the said County Court and prayeth that his Recognizance as aforesaid as an Evidence against the said William Pope may be discharged

Ordered by this Court here that William Burcann his Recognizance taken as aforesaid for his Appearance to this Court be discharged as prayed

William Burcann his Recognizance taken as aforesaid is by this Court here discharged there being no cause
