Thereupon Daniel Finckler John Smithers and Benjamin
Sutton and present here into Court in their proper Persons
Acknowledged themselves Debtor to his Lordship the right
Honourable the Lord Proprietor of Maryland Daniel Finckler
in the sum of twenty pounds current money of the Province
and John Smithers and Benjamin Sutton in the sum
of ten pounds like money Each to be made and conveyed on
their body goods and Chattels Lands and Tenements for the
Use of the said Lordship his heirs and Successors With Condition
to this Recognizance that Daniel Finckler do make his personal
Appearance before the Justices of Our next County Court to be
held at the Court house in Shrewsbury Town on the third Wednesday
November next There and there to Answer unto such things as
shall be Objected against him on his Esq^r behalf And in
the mean time to keep the peace and be of good behav^r
Then this Recognizance to be Void and to remain in
full force in Law

This Court's Command was given to the Sheriff
of Kent County on the fifthteenth
William Bradshaw Day of August in the 24th Year
of Our Dominion & in the Year of Our Lord 1738 that
he should take William Bradshaw late of Kent County
Plaintiff and him safe keep so that you have his body
Immediately before the Court to Answer unto an Oath
And
