 Indorsed as folow vizt before the court of W<sup>t</sup> Harris from Kent Co<sup>y</sup>.  
 Ordered by this Court held that William Bradshaw enter into Recognizance  
 with Surety for his Appearance and good behaviour during Courts  
 sitting and in the mean time to keep the peace and be of good  
 behaviour

Thereupon William Bradshaw and Ralph Page present  
 herein Court in their proper persons Acknowledged themselves to  
 be Indebted to his Lordship the Right Honourable Lord Proprietor  
 of Maryland in the sum of ten Pounds current money of the Province  
 at each to be made and recovered on their body goods and  
 Chattels Lands and Tenements for the use of his said Lordship  
 his heirs and Successors With Condition to this Recognizance  
 that William Bradshaw do make his personall Appearance  
 before the Justy of this present Court now held for Kent Co<sup>y</sup>  
 to Answer unto what shall be Objected against him on his Body  
 behalf on Sufficient of an Assault and in the mean time to  
 keep the peace and be of good behaviour. Then this recognizance  
 to be void Else to remain in full force in case

Ordered by this Court held that Edward Harris enter into  
 Recognizance for his Appearance as on Bore and in behalfe of his
