I certify for W<sup>m</sup> Harris Sheriff Kent Co<sup>y</sup>. Ordered by this Court here that William Bradshaw enter into Recognizance with Security for his Appearance and good behaviour during Courts sitting and in the mean time to keep the peace and be of good behaviour

Thereupon William Bradshaw and Ralph Page present herein Court in their proper persons Acknowledgeth themselves to be Debted to his Lordship the right Honourable the Lord Proprietor of Maryland in the sum of ten pounds current money of the Province of each to be made and Secured on their body goods and Chatter Lands and Tenements for the Use of his said Lordship his heirs and Successors With Condition to this Recognizance that William Bradshaw do make his personal Appearance before the Justice of this present Court now held for Kent County to Answer unto what shall be Objected against him on his own behalf on Suspition of an assault And in the mean time to keep the peace and be of good behaviour. Thus this Recognizance observed and to remain in full force in Law

Ordered by this Court here that Edward Harris enter into Recognizance for his Appearance as an Obedient in behalf of his Lordship against the said William Bradshaw

Thereupon Edward Harris of Kent County Gent and Sheriff herein Court in his proper person Acknowledgeth himself Debted to his Lordship the right Honourable the Lord Proprietor of Maryland in the sum of five pounds current money of the Province of each to be made and Secured on his body goods and Chatter Lands and Tenements for the Use of his said Lordship his heirs and Successors With Condition to this Recognizance that Edw<sup>d</sup>. Harris do make his personal Appearance before the Justice of this present Court now held for Kent County then and there to give
