Therefore it is considered by the Justice heretofore at
Kent County Court at the Court now in the Town of Charles in
said County on the third day of August being the fifteenth
day of said month in the year of Our Lord Seventeen hundred
thirty and eight that the said Joseph pay the sum
of ten Shillings current money of Maryland as a fine for
refusing to aid and assist the Law thereof as also
it is considered by the Justice at the time and place
as last mentioned that the said Joseph pay the sum of
Pounds of tobacco to be raised on
on the premises and to the Officers of this Court

Ordered by this Court here that the fine and to be delivered the
Sheriff of Kent County and William Harris Esq Sheriff of
Kent County and present herein Court Acknowledge the
Receipt of the same
