The Vordships of Kent Countye Be it remembered  
that on the third day of June Anno  
Robert Ferrill, & Domin 1738 came before me the  
Subscriber One of his Vordships Justices of the Peace  
for the said County Robert Ferrill William Smith and  
John Woodall and acknowledged themselves Judged  
unto his Vordship the Lord Propy of Maryland (that  
is to say) Robert Ferrill in the Sum of threescore  
current money of the Province and William  
Smith and John Woodall in the sum of Ten pounds  
like money each to be made and levied on their body  
goods and Chatter Lands and Tenements for the use  
of his said Vordship his heirs and Successors With  
condition that the said Robert do make his personal  
Appearance before the Justices of our next County  
Court to be held at our Court house in the Town of Kent  
in said County on the third Tuesday of June Instant  
then and there to answer unto such things as shall  
be Objected against him on behalf of his Vordship on  
Suspicion of solemnly taking sundry papers out  
of W<sup>m</sup> Allands Chest, These their Recognizances to  
be void and to remain in full force in Law
