And now heard to wit at First County Court at the Court House in the Town of Chester in said County on the third Tuesday of November being the fourteenth day of said month in the year of Our Lord a thousand seven hundred thirty and eight Cometh the aforesaid Francis by his Attorney aforesaid and prays that the aforesaid Francis be to the Judgment aforesaid may answer

And the aforesaid Francis in his proper person comes & Defends the said Francis when he said that he cannot give way the Judgment aforesaid so as againe then brought nor can he say but that he is guilty of the premises aforesaid upon him supposed as by the aforesaid Judgment it is Alledged & thereupon Submit to the Court

Therefore it is Considered by the Justice here to wit at First County Court at the Court House in the Town of Chester in said County on the third Tuesday of November being the fourteenth day of said month in the year of Our Lord a thousand seven hundred thirty and eight that the aforesaid Francis should pay the sum of five Shillings Current in money of Maryland as a fine for Committing the aforesaid Offence Alvo it is Considered by the Justice aforesaid at the time & place aforesaid mentioned that the said Francis Jones pay the sum of Eighty six pounds of tobacco Costs Accruing on the aforesaid to the Officers of this Court

Ordered by this Court here that the fine aforesaid be delivered the Sher of First County. *Thomas Wilmer* Just. of First County being present herein Court at New-
