Therefore it is Considered by the Justices here to
 wit at Kent County Court at the Court House in the Town of
 Chester in said County on the third Tuesday of November
 being the fourteenth day of said month in the year of Our Lord
 one thousand hundred thirty and eight that the aforesaid Francis Jones
 pay the sum of two Shillings Current money of Maryland
 as a fine for Committing the aforesaid Offense Also it is —
 Considered by the Justices aforesaid that he have and pay
 mentioned that the said Francis Jones pay the sum of
 Eighty six pounds of tobacco Cotts according on the offes-
 aforesaid to the Officer of this Court &c —
