Promises as to the Officers of this Court. Thus this Procurance to be void  
if it should remain in full force power and Virtue in Law —

The Lordship's Command was given to the Sheriff of Front County  
William Pope on the 19<sup>th</sup> Day of August in the 2<sup>d</sup> Year of his Majesty  
Dom<sup>us</sup> in the year of Our Lord God Jesus Christ a thousand  
three hundred thirty eight that he should take William Pope late of St. Pauls Parish in  
the County of Labourer if he should be found in his Bailwick & him safe  
bring so that he laws his body before the Justice of Our said County Court  
to be held at Our Court house in the Town of Chester in said County on  
the third Monday of November next to answer unto a certain Procurance  
for assaulting John Finch & Daniel that the said Sheriff had at his time  
& place as the said Writt & Order were here to wit at Front County Court  
at the Court house in the Town of Chester in said County on the third Monday  
of November being the fourteenth day of said month in the year of Our Lord  
Jesus Christ a thousand three hundred thirty eight Cometh Simon Wilmer Justice of  
Front County & made return thereof to the Court there the said Justice  
as follows Viz. Expi Corpus of S. Wilmer the Front County Court  
Front County of the Jurors for the right honourable the Lord Prop<sup>y</sup>  
that now is for the body of Front County as upon their Oath doth shew  
that W<sup>m</sup> Pope late of Saint Pauls Parish in the County of  
Labourer the tenth day of August in the year of Our Lord a thousand  
three hundred thirty eight at the Parish of in the County of & within the  
Jurisdiction of this Court in & upon John Finch in the presence of God &  
of the said Lord Prop<sup>y</sup> then there being then & there with forcible  
an assault did make & the same John Finch then & there did beat wound & scold  
beat so that of his life it was greatly impaired & other harme to him  
from & there did to the great damage of the same John Finch against the peace  
of God & the said Lord Prop<sup>y</sup> his good rule & Government & Gratified
