Ordered by this Court here that the ap Elisha Reed enter into recogniz<sup>er</sup> with security for his appearance to next Court to answer unto the indictment of fornication — Thereupon Elisha Reed, Nath<sup>l</sup> Kenward & Caleb Wock of West County Labourers and present heron Court in their proper persons Acknowledg<sup>ed</sup> themselves Indebted to his Lordship the right honourable the Lord Prop<sup>er</sup> of Maryland in the sum of twenty pounds Curr<sup>ent</sup> money of the Province ap and Nath<sup>l</sup> Kenward & Caleb Wock in the sum of ten pounds like money each to be made & payed on their body goods & Chattel<sup>er</sup> Lands & Tenements for the use of his said Dy<sup>er</sup> this hour & since now with Condition to this recogniz<sup>er</sup> that Elisha Reed do make his personal App<sup>er</sup> before the Justices of Our next County Court to be held at Our Court house in the Town of Chester in said County on the third Tuesday of March next then and there to stand & abide the Judgment of the Court Then this recogniz<sup>er</sup> to be void & to remain in full force in Law —

Ordered by this Court here that Jane Reed give security for her App<sup>er</sup> to next March Court as an Evid<sup>er</sup> in behalf of his Lordship ag<sup>st</sup> the ap Elisha Reed — Thereupon Jane Reed of West County Spinster & present heron Court Acknowledg<sup>ed</sup> herself Indebted to his Dy<sup>er</sup> the right Honourable the Lord Prop<sup>er</sup> of Maryland in the sum of five pounds Curr<sup>ent</sup> money of the Province ap to be made & payed on her body goods & Chattel<sup>er</sup> Lands & Tenements for the use of his said Lordship this hour & since now with Condition to this recogniz<sup>er</sup> that Jane Reed do make her personal App<sup>er</sup> before the Justices of Our next County Court to be held at Our Court house in the Town of Chester in said County on the third Tuesday of March next then and there to give in Evidence in behalf of his Lordship against the ap Elisha Reed Then this recogniz<sup>er</sup> to be void & to remain in full force in Law —
