SECTION 1. *Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland,* That Section 45D of Article 19 of the Code of Public Local Laws of Maryland (1930 Edition), title "St. Mary's County", sub-title "Classified Service", as last amended by Chapter 347 of 1961, be and it is hereby repealed and re-enacted, with amendments, to read as follows:

45D. Unless the context otherwise requires: "County Commissioners" means the County Commissioners of St. Mary's County; "Commissioner of Personnel" means State Commissioner of Personnel; "Classified Service" means and includes the following offices and positions: All employees of the County Roads Department, including hourly rate employees and all employees of the Department of Civil Defense [;], and such other employees of the County as the Commissioners may designate; "Classified Position" or "Position" means any office in the classified service; "Classified Service Employee" or "Employee" means a person who holds, under the terms of this sub-title, a position in the classified service, but shall not include a person employed by contract to render a temporary or special service for the county.

SEC. 2. *And be it further enacted,* That this Act shall take effect June 1, 1963.

CHAPTER 64

(Senate Bill 104)

AN ACT to repeal Section 6 of the Code of Public Local Laws of Cecil County (1961 Edition, being Article 8 of the Code of Public Local Laws of Maryland), title "Cecil County", sub-title "Building Permits", and to repeal said sub-title, repealing an obsolete and unnecessary local law of Cecil County concerning the issue and use of building permits.

SECTION 1. *Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland,* That Section 6 of the Code of Public Local Laws of Cecil County (1961 Edition, being Article 8 of the Code of Public Local Laws of Maryland), title "Cecil County", sub-title "Building Permits", be and it is hereby repealed; and that said sub-title be and it is hereby repealed.

SEC. 2. *And be it further enacted,* That this Act shall take effect June 1, 1963.
