PLANNING BOARD MAY STIPULATE THE TOTAL TIME THAT WILL BE ALLOTTED TO THE HEARING, WHICH TIME SHALL BE DIVIDED EQUALLY BETWEEN THE PROPONENTS AND THE PROTESTANTS AS THE CASE MAY BE. THE PLANAMENDMENT. THE PLANNING BOARD MAY SHALL TAKE ACTION, BY RESOLUTION, IMMEDIATELY FOLLOWING A HEARING OR AT ANY TIME THEREAFTER, WITHIN THE TIME LIMITATIONS OF THIS SECTION. THE PLANNING BOARD'S RESOLUTION TRANSMITTING ITS RECOMMENDATIONS ON SUCH APPLICATIONS SHALL INCLUDE A ONLY ITS SUMMARY STATEMENT SETTING FORTH THE BASIS FOR ITS ACTION.

- (C) HEARING. BEFORE ANY REGULATION OR REGULATIONS AUTHORIZED BY THIS SUB-HEADING MAY BE PASSED, THE DISTRICT COUNCIL SHALL HOLD A PUBLIC HEARING THEREON AND SHALL GIVE NOTICE OF THE TIME AND PLACE THEREOF BY ONE INSERTION IN TWO NEWSPAPERS OF GENERAL CIRCULATION RESPECTIVELY IN THE COUNTY IN WHICH THE PROPERTY IS LOCATED. THE INSERTIONS SHALL APPEAR IN SAID NEWSPAPER AT LEAST THIRTY (30) DAYS PRIOR TO THE DATE OF HEARING BUT NOT MORE THAN THIRTY-EIGHT (38) DAYS BEFORE THE DATE OF THE HEARING. DURING THIS THIRTY-DAY PERIOD THE TEXT OR COPY OF THE TEXT OF THE REGULA-TIONS, TOGETHER WITH THE MAP OR MAPS FORMING PART OF OR REFERRED TO IN THE REGULATIONS, SHALL BE ON FILE FOR PUBLIC EXAMINATION IN THE OFFICE OF THE COUNTY COUNCIL OF MONTGOMERY COUNTY OR IN THE OFFICE OF THE CLERK TO THE COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF PRINCE GEORGE'S COUNTY. THE COST OF ADVERTIS-ING IN CONNECTION WITH PUBLICATION OF PROPOSED AMENDMENTS IN THE ZONING REGULATIONS OR MAPS SHALL BE PAID BY THE PERSONS OR CORPORATIONS MAK-ING APPLICATION FOR SUCH CHANGES.
- REFERRAL TO INCORPORATED MUNICIPALITIES. BEFORE THE DISTRICT COUNCIL OF THE MARYLAND-WASHINGTON REGIONAL DISTRICT IN MONTGOMERY AND PRINCE GEORGE'S COUNTY MAY AMEND THE ZONING ORDINANCE OF EITHER COUNTY BY CHANGING THE ZON-ING CLASSIFICATION OF PROPERTY WITHIN ANY INCOR-PORATED MUNICIPALITY, THE APPLICATION FOR SUCH CHANGE SHALL BE REFERRED TO THE GOVERNING BODY OF SUCH INCORPORATED MUNICIPALITY FOR ITS RECOM-MENDATION; PROVIDED, HOWEVER, THAT IN MONTGOMERY COUNTY A TWO-THIRDS MAJORITY VOTE OF ALL THE MEMBERS OF THE DISTRICT COUNCIL SHALL BE REQUIRED BEFORE SAID COUNCIL MAY CHANGE THE ZONING CLASSI-FICATION OF PROPERTY WITHIN ANY INCORPORATED MUNICIPALITY CONTRARY TO THE RECOMMENDATION OF SUCH MUNICIPALITY THEREON. FOR PURPOSES OF THIS SECTION THE TERM "INCORPORATED MUNICIPALITY" SHALL INCLUDE ANY CITY, TOWN, VILLAGE, OR ANY SPE-CIAL TAXING AREA WHICH HAS AN ELECTED LOCAL GOV-ERNING BODY AND PERFORMS GENERAL MUNICIPAL FUNCTIONS.
