

(2) Encourage location of new industrial enterprises in the county and the expansions of present enterprises.

(3) Encourage development of recreational areas and encourage tourist business in the county, making the public aware of the county's historical background and progress.

(4) Disseminate information in the interest of industrial development by publication, advertising and other means.

(5) Cooperate with any federal, state, local agency, board or commission including the Economic Development Commission of Maryland, in the furtherance of its purposes.

(6) Cooperate with any interested private concern, civic organization or subdivision thereof in furtherance of the Commission's purposes.

SEC. 2. And be it further enacted, That this Act shall take effect June 1, 1963.

CHAPTER 731

(House Bill 613)

AN ACT to add new Section 43 to Article 40 of the Annotated Code of Maryland (1962 Supplement), title "General Assembly," to follow immediately after Section 42 thereof and to be under the new subtitle "Members' Leaves of Absence," relating to leaves of absence of members of the General Assembly employed, other than for such membership, by State and local governments and provide for such membership, by State and local governments AND TO LEAVES OF ABSENCE FOR EMPLOYEES OF THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY WHO ARE EMPLOYED, OTHER THAN FOR SUCH EMPLOYMENT, BY THE STATE OR ANY POLITICAL SUBDIVISION THEREOF, and providing that their attendance OR EMPLOYMENT AS THE CASE MAY BE at any session of the General Assembly shall not impair rights of tenure, sick and annual leave nor any other incidents of such employment excepting wages during such sessions.

SECTION 1. *Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland,* That new Section 43 be and it is hereby added to Article 40 of the Annotated Code of Maryland (1962 Supplement), title "General Assembly," to follow immediately after Section 42 thereof, to be under the new subtitle "Members' Leaves of Absence," and to read as follows:

*All members of the General Assembly employed, other than for such membership, by the State or any POLITICAL subdivision thereof, AND ALL EMPLOYEES OF THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY WHO ARE EMPLOYED, OTHER THAN FOR SUCH EMPLOYMENT, BY THE STATE OR ANY POLITICAL SUBDIVISION THEREOF, shall be entitled to an automatic leave of absence from such employ-*
