title "Fees of Officers", sub-title "Attorneys", and to repeal and re-enact, with amendments, Section 176 of the Code of Public Local Laws of Harford County (1957 Edition, being Article 13 of the Code of Public Local Laws of Maryland), title "Harford County", sub-title "Circuit Court", sub-heading "Court Stenographer", to provide for disposition of a portion of the appearance fees of attorneys in Harford County to be used for the purposes of the Court Library of the County and to remove a requirement that the court stenographer of the County act as librarian for the Bar Library in the county.

SECTION 1. Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland, That Section 10 of Article 36 of the Annotated Code of Maryland (1957 Edition), title "Fees of Officers", sub-title "Attorneys", be and it is hereby repealed and re-enacted, with amendments; and that Section 176 of the Code of Public Local Laws of Harford County (1957 Edition, being Article 13 of the Code of Public Local Laws of Maryland), title "Harford County", sub-title "Circuit Court", sub-heading "Court Stenographer", be and it is hereby repealed and re-enacted, with amendments, all to read as follows:

(a) Attorneys at law shall be entitled to demand and receive the following fees, to wit:

For bringing, prosecuting or defending any suit or action at law in any of the courts of this State of original jurisdiction.....\$ 5.00

(b) In Harford County, the clerk of the circuit court for the county shall deposit twenty percentum (20%) of all appearance fees collected by him under the provisions of sub-section (a) above into a special account to be used for the general purposes of the Court Library of the county.
