## (Senate Joint Resolution 14)

Senate Joint Resolution requesting the Legislative Council to appoint a Committee to study the problem of inconsistent fire codes throughout the State and to make a recommendation with regard to the problem and to propose legislation to the Council, if applicable.

WHEREAS, the fire codes of the various counties and Baltimore City are inconsistent with each other; and

WHEREAS, there is no uniform code throughout the State; and

WHEREAS, this presents many problems to persons owning property in different areas in the State and equally perplexing problems to builders and electricians who work outside of one locale; and

Whereas, it is the opinion of the General Assembly of Maryland that this variety and differentiation among the various counties and Baltimore City is a real problem and should be studied at length; now, therefore, be it

Resolved by the General Assembly of Maryland, That the Legislative Council be and it is hereby requested to appoint a Committee to study the entire problem of individual and different fire codes throughout the State; and be it further

Resolved, That the Council is requested to appoint to this Committee a representative group of persons from all sections in the State; and be it further
