I, LLOYD L. SIMPKINS, SECRETARY OF STATE OF THE STATE OF MARYLAND, pursuant to the direction contained in Section 172 of Article 33 of the Annotated Code of Maryland, (1957 Edition,) DO HEREBY CERTIFY, that at the General Election held in the State of Maryland on November 6, 1962, an Act known as Chapter 721 of the Acts of 1961 was submitted to the voters of the Seventh Election District of Anne Arundel County under the provisions of Chapter 721 of the Acts of 1961, said Act being as follows:

“An Act to repeal and re-enact, with amendments, Section 28 (c) of Article 2B of the Annotated Code of Maryland (1960 Supplement), title ‘Alcoholic Beverages,’ subtitle ‘Local Licenses and License Provisions,’ relating to the alcoholic content of beverages sold by alcoholic beverage Licensees in the Seventh Election District of Anne Arundel County, and providing for a referendum thereon.”

AND I DO CERTIFY that at said election, 586 votes were cast in favor of adoption of Chapter 721 of the Acts of 1961 and 351 votes were cast against adoption of said Chapter 721 of the Acts of 1961, the said Act has therefore been ratified by a majority of the qualified voters of the Seventh Election District of Anne Arundel County.
