

SECTION 1. *Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland,* That Section 143A of Article 5 of the Code of Public Local Laws of Maryland (1930 Edition), title "Calvert County", sub-title "Installation of Electrical Apparatus and Wiring", as said section was enacted by Chapter 553 of the Acts of 1933, be and it is hereby repealed and re-enacted with amendments to read as follows:

143A. That there is hereby created a Board of Electrical Examiners and Supervisors for Calvert County, the said Board to consist of three persons, for the purpose of examining into the qualifications and capabilities of all persons who are engaged or desire to engage in the business of Master Electrician as defined in this sub-title. [The present board created by this sub-title shall be B. G. Loveless, North Beach, Maryland; George W. Dorsey, Prince Frederick, Maryland, and the President of the Board of County Commissioners for Calvert County, who shall serve until the end of the term of the present Governor, after which time the] *The* said board shall be appointed by the Governor and shall consist of the President of the Board of County Commissioners for Calvert County and two competent, practical electricians residing in Calvert County, for a term of three years. Should any vacancy occur from any cause during the term of any board as herein provided, the Governor shall appoint someone to fill such vacancy. The Governor shall have full power to remove any member of the Board for incompetency or improper conduct upon satisfactory evidence being presented to him of such condition.

SEC. 2. *And be it further enacted,* That this Act shall take effect June 1, 1963.

CHAPTER 26

(Senate Bill 54)

AN ACT to repeal ~~and re-enact with amendments~~ Sections 148 and 149 of Article 5 of the Code of Public Local Laws of Maryland (1930 Edition), title "Calvert County", sub-title "Fines", and to repeal said sub-title, repealing certain obsolete and unnecessary local laws of Calvert County having to do with the collection and disposition of certain fines, penalties and forfeitures.

SECTION 1. *Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland,* That Sections 148 and 149 of Article 5 of the Code of Public Local Laws of Maryland (1930 Edition), title "Calvert County", sub-title "Fines", and that said sub-title be and they are hereby repealed, as follows:

[148. All moneys, fines, penalties and forfeitures collected by or coming into the hands of the sheriff, justice of the peace and other officers of Calvert County, and which are now paid or may hereafter be made payable to the County Commissioners for the use of said
