(House Joint Resolution 34)

(House Joint Resolution 42)

House Joint Resolution, Memorializing for a second time the Congress of the United States to amend Public Local Law 86-669, enacted July 14, 1960, such law being a part of the National Capital Transportation Act of 1960, to permit the District of Columbia to proceed with the planning and construction of that portion of Interstate Route 70S within the District of Columbia in order that the State of Maryland may complete the construction of Interstate Route 70S through that State to the District of Columbia line.
