## INTRODUCTION OF BILLS

Senate Bill No. 33-By Senator Pine:

A Bill entitled: An Act to repeal Chapter 380 of the Acts of 1963 and to repeal Sections 159-166A, inclusive, of Article 33 of the Annotated Code of Maryland (1957 Edition and 1963 Supplement), title "Elections", sub-title "House of Representatives", and to enact in lieu thereof new Sections 159-166A, inclusive, to stand in the place of the sections so repealed, revising the several congressional districts in this State for the election of representatives in the Congress of the United States, creating a new Eighth Congressional District, making special provision for the filing of certificates of candidacy for the primary election in the year 1964 for the office of representative in the Congress of the United States, repealing certain laws and procedures inconsistent with this Act, and relating generally to the boundaries of the several Congressional Districts in this State and to the election of representatives to fill these offices.
