title "Unsatisfied Claim and Judgment Fund", to follow immediately after Section 158 thereof, to provide that persons holding valid automobile liability insurance policies issued by companies authorized to do business under the Insurance Code meet motor vehicle financial responsibility requirements regardless of the insolvency or inability of the insurer to pay judgments against the insured, and to provide that such policyholders need not pay uninsured motorist fees except upon certain conditions.
