

Amendment No. 3—In lines 9, 10 and 11 of the title of the printed bill, strike out the following: “in order to make these laws State-wide in effect; and also to repeal present provisions for a referendum election on the effect of these laws in Carroll County”, and insert in lieu thereof the following: “and continuing the exemption from these subtitles for Dorchester and Worcester Counties”.
