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**INTRODUCTION OF BILLS**

Senate Bill No. 1—By the President:

AN ACT to repeal Sections 288(k), 289(f-3) and 289(f-4) of Article 81 of the Annotated Code of Maryland (1957 Edition and 1964 Supplement), title "Revenue and Taxes," subtitle "Income Tax," and to repeal and re-enact with amendments Sections 288 (c-1), 288 (c-2) and 289 (f-1) of said Article and subtitle, and to repeal Section 2 of Chapter 17 of the Acts of the Regular Session of 1964, relating generally to income taxes in this State; and making an appropriation from any funds in the general
