Senate Bill No. 5—By Senator Pine:

AN ACT to provide for the retirement of George M. Berry, one of the Associate Judges of the Third Judicial Circuit of Maryland, he having become unable to discharge his duties with efficiency by reason of continued sickness.

Which was read the first time and referred to the Committee on Rules.

Senate Bill No. 6—By the City Senators:

AN ACT to repeal Subsection (33½) (b) of Section 6 of Article 4 of the Code of Public Local Laws of Maryland and Baltimore City Charter (1949 Edition), title "Baltimore City," subtitle "General Powers," subheading "Taxes," as said subsection was enacted by Chapter 27 of the Acts of 1951, repealing certain restrictions upon the power of the Mayor and City Council of Baltimore to have and exercise taxing powers within the limits of Baltimore City.

Which was read the first time and referred to the Committee on Rules.

Senate Bill No. 7—By the City Senators (By request):

AN ACT to repeal and re-enact, with amendments, subsection 33½ (b) of Section 6 of the Charter and Public Local Laws of Baltimore City (1949 Edition), being Article 4 of the Code of Public Local Laws of Maryland, title "Baltimore City," subtitle "General Powers," subheading "Taxes," as said Section was enacted by Chapter 27 of the Acts of 1951, eliminating the prohibition against the imposition of an income tax by Baltimore City and clarifying the provisions of this section.

Which was read the first time and referred to the Committee on Rules.

Senate Bill No. 8-By Senator Clark:

AN ACT to repeal and re-enact, with amendments, Section 152E (a) of the Code of Public Local Laws of Howard County (1957 Edition, being Article 14 of the Code of Public Local Laws of Maryland), title "Howard County," subtitle "People's Court of Howard County," as proposed to be amended by Chapter 36 of the Acts of the First Special Session of 1964, to change the salaries of the Judges of the People's Court of Howard County.

Which was read the first time and referred to the Committee on Rules.

Senate Bill No. 9—By Senator Alton:

AN ACT to authorize an extension, for the calendar year 1964 only, of the time within which the County Commissioners of Anne Arundel County are required by law to adopt the county budget, fix the general and special tax rates in the county, and to impose the county tax levy for the ensuing fiscal year.

Which was read the first time and referred to the Committee on Rules.
