

MESSAGE TO THE HOUSE OF DELEGATES

By Senator Wheatley:

We have received your message notifying the Senate of the organization of your Honorable Body, and proposing a joint committee of five members, three on the part of the House and two on the part of the Senate, to wait upon the Governor and inform him that the General Assembly is now prepared to receive any communications which he may desire to make.
