Leave was granted to the committee on Claims to bring in a bill ascertaining and defining the duties of the armorer of this State.

And to the committee on the Militia, to bring in a bill to define the duties of Adjutant the General.

Mr. Harne then moved to reconsider the vote on the resolutions in relation to the postage accounts of the members of the Legislature.

Mr. Brown then moved to lay the said motion on the table; Determined in the negative.
