Mr. Janney then moved to amend the title of said bill, by strik-

ing out the whole of it and inserting the following:
"An act to destroy the breed of fish and all the fisheries on the

Susquehanna, Elk, North East, Sasafras and Bohemia rivers;"
Od the question being put, it was determined in the negative.

The bill was then sent to the Senate.

The Speaker laid before the House the report of Clover Hill Academy, in Carroll county;

Read and referred to the committee on Education.

And the following communications from the Commissioner of Loans:

The amount transmitted by him to the agents for the State was £10,000, or \$44,444 44. It consisted of sixty day bills on London and Liverpool, and was sent in his letter of the 29th October, 1841. It was to be applied to pay the interest due on the 1st January, 1842, in London. The above amount, together with the interest due at this office on 1st October, 1841, was borrowed by the undersigned, for the use of the State, under resolution No. 3, passed at the March session of 1841; after having paid the interest due here, the balance of the sum borrowed was remitted to London, (excepting a small sum paid for sterling coupons held in this State,) and to close the account, a draft was drawn on the Treasurer of the Western Shore for

Paid for £10,000 in bills at 13 per ct. \$50,222 22

Paid for coupons held here £1137 10,

at 13 per ct. - 5,712 77
