And the bill entitled, an act to repeal a supplement to an act to authorise the appointment of justices of the peace in the city of Baltimore with limited jurisdiction, passed at December session 1825, chapter 189.

Severally endorsed "will pass"—ordered to be engrossed.

The Speaker laid before the House the following communication from the Treasurer of the Western Shore:

As he has not answered, and did not intend to answer the last, (No. 8,) which, but for the call of the House, would have been simply handed to the chairman of its committee of Ways and Means, with such remarks as occurred to him, the Treasurer asks leave to state that, the writer, as will be seen, has misapprehended his annual report—and that the suggestions of the letter are to be considered as exclusively the agent's—which, as the Treasurer had already distinctly stated, both to the agent and his principals, he declined to entertain officially.
