Resolved by the General Assembly of Maryland, That the Adjutant General be, and he is hereby authorised to deliver to Captain Samuel Whittington, of Calvert county, the additional number of five rifles, with their necessary accourtements, provided they are in the armory, upon the said Whittington giving a sufficient bond for their safe keeping and return whenever required to

do so;

Which was read, assented to and sent to the Senate.

Read the second time by special order, passed and sent to the

Senate.

Mr. Holland reported a bill entitled, an act requiring the commissioners Worcester county, to contract with their clerk or clerks,
