

Mr. Graves, chairman of the committee on Ways and Means, to which was recommitted the bill entitled, an act supplementary to the acts passed at December session 1835, chapters 313, 314, 315, and the supplements thereto, reported that the committee were still of the opinion that the said bill ought to pass;

Read the second time by special order.

Mr. Hammond then moved to amend the said bill by striking out the second section;

The House then resumed the consideration of the order of the day.

The question still being on the amendment submitted by Mr. Brown, to strike out in the third clause of the preamble all from the word "Government" to the end of the said clause, and insert "the power to make all needful rules and regulations respecting the territory or other property belonging to the United States."

After some time spent in the discussion thereof, and before the question was put;

Mr. Traverse moved that the House do now adjourn;
