Mr. Crookshanks reported a bill entitled, an act to authorise the commissioners of Cecil county to issue summons or citations;
Read the first time.

Mr. Hammond reported a bill entitled, a supplement to the act entitled, an act passed at December session 1838, chapter 205, relating to the lien of mechanics and others upon buildings;

Read the first, and by special order the second time, passed and sent to the Senate.

Mr. Rider reported a bill entitled, an act to authorise the commissioners of Somerset county to appoint a collector of the county levy separately from the collector of the direct tax;

Read the first time.

Mr. Hammond submitted the following message:

*By the House of Delegates,
February 9th, 1843.*

Gentlemen of the Senate:

The bill entitled, an act to authorise and require the Clerk of the Court of Appeals to reinstate and place upon the docket of that court, the case herein referred to, was passed on the 30th of January, by this House, upon information derived from one of the parties to be effected alone, we therefore desire to investigate still further the merits of the subject; and if agreeable to your honorable body, we ask that the said bill may be returned to this House, if the same has not been acted upon by you.

Which was read, assented to and sent to the Senate.

Ordered, That the report of the select committee on the Farmers and Millers Bank of Washington County, be made the order of the day for Saturday next.

The House then resumed the consideration of the preamble and resolution submitted by Mr. Causin, in relation to the issue of \$200,000,000 of Government stock.
