Mr. Hammond presented the memorial of Allen Thomas, trustee of Robert Oliver, asking that a case therein referred to, may not be reinstated in the Court of Appeals;

Read and referred to the committee on Grievances and Courts of Justice.

Mr. Gallagher, chairman of the committee on Corporations, to which was referred the bill entitled, an act to prevent the circulation of non-specie paying bank notes, and other paper within this State, reported the same without amendment;

Read the first time and ordered to be printed.

Mr. Handy of Somerset, from the committee on lotteries, reported a bill entitled, an act supplementary to an act entitled, an act to revive the twelfth, thirteenth, fourteenth and fifteenth sections of an act passed at December session 1815, chapter 166, entitled, an act to incorporate a company to make a turnpike road from the Frederick and Baltimore turnpike, commencing at the west end of Fredericktown to Harpers Ferry, on the Potomac river, passed at December session 1838, chapter 268;

Read the first and by special order the second time, passed and sent to the Senate.

Mr. Buchanan, from the committee on Corporations, to which was referred the bill entitled, an act to incorporate a company to make a turnpike road from the town of Cumberland, by the nearest and most practicable route to the Pennsylvania line, in the direction of Bedford, Pennsylvania, reported the same without amendment;

Read the first time.

The House took up the bill entitled, an act for protection of mechanics and others, in Washington county;

Read the second time by special order, passed to and sent to the Senate.

Mr. Buchanan, from the committee on Corporations, to which was referred the bill entitled, an act to incorporate a company to make a turnpike road from some point on the National road at or west of the town of Cumberland, thence by the nearest and most practicable route, through any point of Allegany county, so as to intersect the North Western Turnpike road of Virginia, reported the same without amendment;

Mr. Brown, from the select committee, to which was referred the bill from the Senate entitled, an act to provide for the appointment of a flour inspector and a wood corder in the town of Westminster, in Carroll county, reported the same without amendment;
